



## Confined Space Training

Confined Space Training is very specific to the hazards present, the type of space/drain/vessel/culvert to be entered, and the duration of time within the confined space and the equipment available for use by employees.

The companies risk assessments along with the PPE available will be incorporated into the training and where possible a live exercise will be included within the training course.

The Confined Space Training course will be as site and risk specific as possible and a full course syllabus will be agreed with the client to ensure all of the objectives are met.

All courses include:

- Definition of enclosed/confined spaces
- Hazard analyses to include gas, vapour, dust, liquids and steam
- Confined Space entry permits
- Atmosphere checks and monitoring including long and short term exposure limits LTEL/STEL.
- Explosive atmospheres
- Top man duties
- Extraction devices i.e. Tri or Quad pods, harness or lifelines
- Positive pressure ventilation systems if required
- Liquid or hazardous substances
- MSDS sheets and their role within Confine Space hazard control
- Personal Protective Equipment

Breathing Apparatus training can be provided if the risk assessments show the requirement during Confine Space Entry.
