COURSE CONTENT:

Risk Assessment Training will instruct trainees in

- Identification, evaluation and control of [health](#) hazards in the working environment with the objective of protecting employee health and well-being and safeguarding others impacted by the workplace and its activities
- Analysis and Evaluation of the major impacts on occupational hygiene:
 - Air Contaminants
 - Chemical Hazards
 - Physical Hazards
 - Biological Hazards
 - Ergonomic Hazards
 - Psychosocial Hazards
- Assessment of the Risk associated with identified Hazards
- Classification / Rating of Risk - Likelihood and Severity
- Risk Reduction – Resolve hazards identified
- Control Measures required including identification of engineering, administrative and personal protective measures to be implemented
- Hierarchy of Control Measures
- Corrective Action and Review Processes
