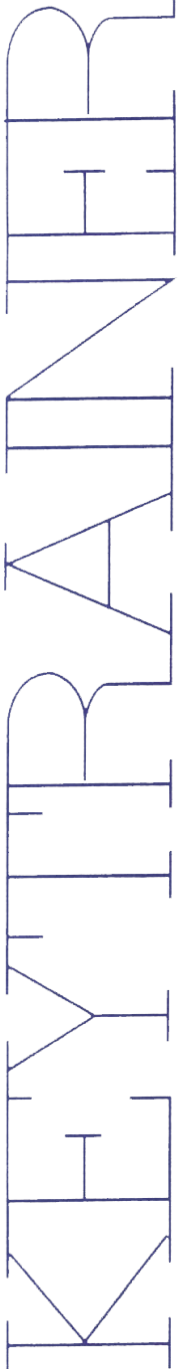
Training Objectives:

- Gain an understanding of health and safety law in regard to risks assessment
- Appreciate the legal duties of employers and employees and the corporate responsibilities for contractors, agency personnel, visitors and others
- Gain a sound practical appreciation of how to carry out risk assessments, including the use of accident investigations
- Be introduced to practical work place tools that delegates will use when they return to their individual work places e.g. check sheets and risk assessment matrixes

Method of Training: The course includes classroom presentation using videos and PowerPoint presentations, followed by real life risk assessments where students will build safe systems of work, method statements and consider special issues such as personal protective equipment (PPE) and training needs.

Students will be encouraged to discuss their own workplace experiences and begin to assess existing measures to control any hazards with balance and measure.

Handouts and all necessary materials are provided for students and signed training records maintained.
